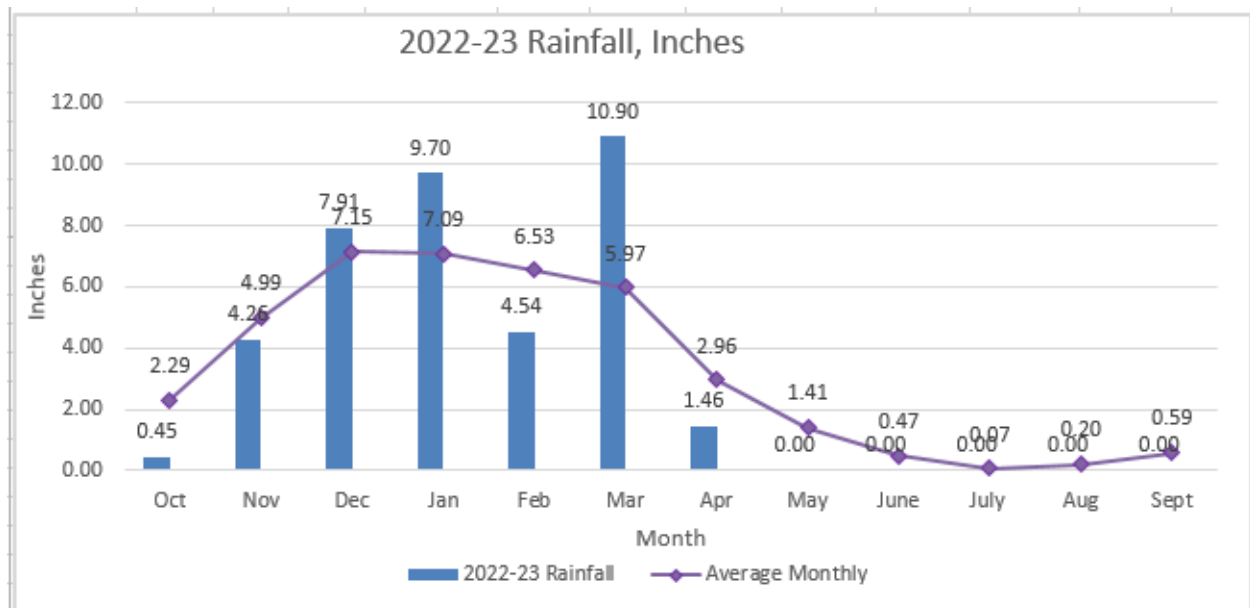

### MCCSD Board Declares a No Water Shortage Condition

On April 19, 2023, at the Mendocino City Community Services District’s regular monthly meeting, the Board of Directors declared a No Water Shortage condition exists within the MCCSD boundaries following above normal rainfall and the Water Shortage Contingency Plan.

The rain year is from October 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>, and average annual precipitation is 39.72 inches. As of March 31, 2023 the District measured 37.76 inches of precipitation since the start of the 2022-23 rain year, which is 95% of average total annual rainfall.

An additional 2-3 inches of rain was recorded between April and early May. During an average rain year, 5.7 inches of rain occurs from April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>. As of May 9, 2023 the District has recorded 102% of average annual rainfall.
